



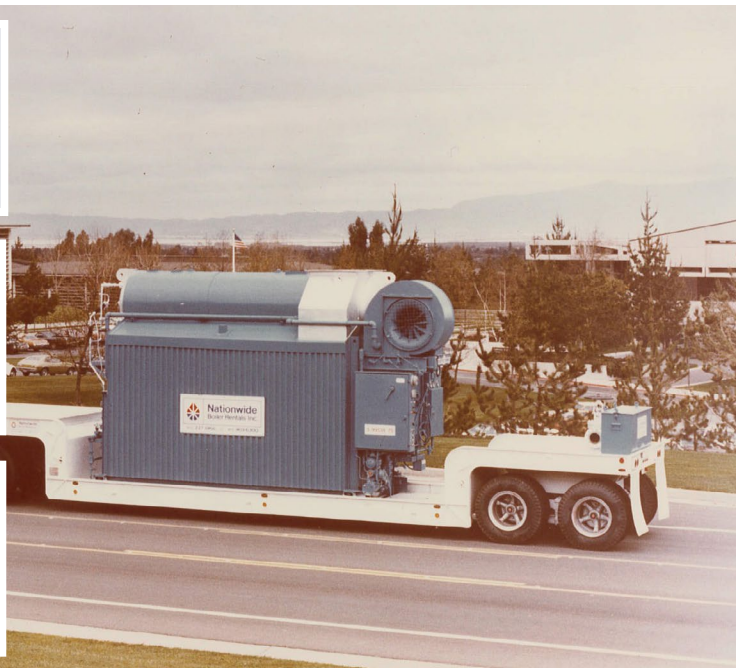

2017 Marks Fifty Years of Firsts at Nationwide Boiler Inc.

In 1967, the average yearly income was \$7,500 and gas was 33 cents per gallon. The average cost of a new car was \$2,750 and the monthly cost to rent a 20,000 lb/hr boiler was \$6,750. Fifty years ago in 1967, Nationwide Boiler Rentals was founded by Dick Bliss and a new era of trailer-mounted, mobile rental boilers had begun.

During his time as a Hartford Steam Boiler Inspector, Richard (Dick) Bliss recognized the need for a more efficient and cost-effective method to provide temporary boilers during emergencies and routine maintenance periods, as well as to meet peak demands. With a new dream in mind, Dick mortgaged his house and bought his first boiler; a new 20,000 lb/hr O-type package watertube boiler. He then mounted the boiler on a permanent, highway-legal

trailer, signaling the start of an entirely new business on the West Coast.

Nationwide Boiler Rentals opened its doors in Mountain View, CA on March 28, 1967. Roughly ten years later, the company was incorporated and renamed to

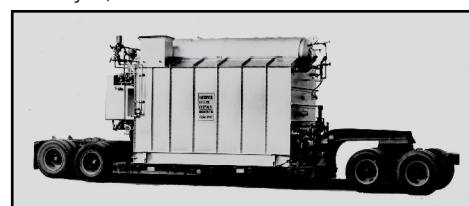


Nationwide Boiler Inc. Headquarters were relocated in 1982 to Fremont, CA to the largest Bay Area warehouse facility at the time.

In the last fifty years, Nationwide Boiler has built a strong reputation of innovation in the industry, and we are celebrating fifty years of firsts. From the first 75,000 lb/hr,

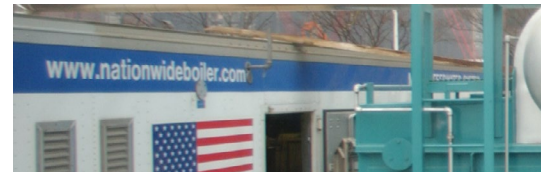
750 psig superheat trailer-mounted boilers, the world's largest 120,000 lb/hr (now 125,000 lb/hr), 400 psig saturated trailer-mounted boiler, and the world's first 1,000 hp, 290 psig design, mobile boiler room. Nationwide's exclusive CataStakTM SCR system was the first SCR system proven to reduce NOx emissions to as low as 2.5 ppm on boilers and the first to be utilized for rental equipment. And our recent product launch, the DataStakTM, is the first fully packaged emissions and efficiency monitoring system. Nationwide Boiler strives to bring new and innovative solutions not just to the industry, but to our customers.

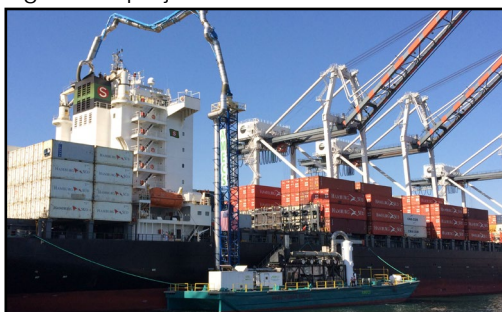
CataStak™ to Support AMECS Barge System

An innovative system designed to reduce ship-based pollution has been developed, and Nationwide's proven Ammonia-Free CataStak™ SCR System has been selected to provide the critical NOx reduction requirements. The Advanced Maritime Emissions Control System (AMECS), a patented technology which is licensed exclusively to AEG, LLC, has successfully demonstrated its ability to capture and eliminate the most harmful exhaust emissions being produced by dock-side, ocean-going vessels.

AEG's AMECS uses its patented "direct connect" technology to attach to the exhaust port of any ocean-going vessel and remove 90-99% of NOx and other pollutants. The system is positioned to cover the vessels auxiliary engine exhaust outlet, capturing the emission stream. The exhaust is then pulled down to the barge based emissions reduction system, where the clean-up equipment is located. This system, which represents a proven-alternative method to shore power for reducing ship-based, in-port emissions, has and will continue to provide a significant and much needed reduction in coastal air pollution levels.

Nationwide Boiler engineers worked closely with AEG, LLC and Milco Constructors for nearly three years to design a unique, application specific, packaged CataStak™ SCR System that will be fully integrated into the larger AMECS barge. The CataStak™ SCR will utilize safe urea (DEF) rather than ammonia as a reagent. It has been designed to meet the strict emissions requirements of the California Air Resource Board and South Coast Air Quality Management District.

Nationwide Boiler is pleased to be working with AEG, LLC and Milco Constructors on such a forward looking, environmentally significant project.



Nationwide Supplies Equipment for Mission Linen's New Facility

Nationwide Boiler serves customers throughout the world, and we have actually supplied equipment to six out of the seven continents. One recent equipment sale was quite unique, as it involved a customer right in our own backyard.

Mission Linen, an industry leading uniform and linen rental and industrial laundry company, operates over forty facilities in California, Arizona, Texas, Oregon and New Mexico. They recently began building a new flagship facility in Newark, CA, just five miles north of Nationwide's headquarters in Fremont.

Nationwide Boiler was chosen to supply the company with all of the boiler related equipment needed to support this new, high-profile operation. This included two 475 hp Superior Mohican, 4-pass Scotch Marine firetube boilers, each equipped with a sub 9 ppm ultra low NOx Power Flame burner. A Superior two-stage, near-condensing stack economizer will be installed on each boiler and will provide a significant increase in boiler efficiency while also providing a large volume of much needed hot water to the facility. A Superior pressurized spray-type deaerating feedwater system

and blowdown separator were also supplied. Given Mission Linen's objective for creating a truly energy and resource efficient operation, Nationwide Boiler will also be providing a DataStak™ emissions and efficiency monitoring system.

All of the primary equipment was shipped to the facility in mid-October. Each piece was rigged over the newly constructed walls and set into place using a large crane. With the boiler equipment successfully set in place, the building construction will now be completed.

This, however, is just the beginning. Nationwide boiler will be providing a complete, turn-key solution for Mission Linen. Once the building construction is complete, Nationwide Boiler will fully install the boiler equipment. The boiler will then be fired, tested and tuned to ensure that the equipment will provide safe, reliable and efficient operation that is in full compliance with the stringent Bay Area Air Quality Management District's emissions requirements.

We began working with Mission Linen to develop this project over three years ago, and are happy to see the project take shape. The new facility is on track and scheduled to be complete mid-2017.

A Humbling Experience



My wife and I recently had the opportunity to go on a 15 day mission trip to Ethiopia. We were part of the Arukah Global Team based out of Silicon Valley, a Christian based organization whose mission is to empower those in Adama (or Nazret)

Ethiopia that are struggling with the devastating effects of poverty, including women and children who are, and were, the victims of human trafficking. Our work there included home building and repairs organized through two different churches, and working on facility improvements at two different schools. In addition, we provided health education and child development services to Ellilta, an organization that works to rehabilitate women from prostitution. We also had the opportunity through Compassion International to visit our sponsored children in the area.

Two weeks before we left, we weren't sure if we were even going. The Ethiopian government imposed a national state of emergency in response to recent protests against the government and subsequent killings. We were advised by many not to go, but our commitment was stronger than our common sense. The day we left we were informed that all social media in Ethiopia was shut down and we were advised no books or pamphlets would be allowed into the country. We left with much anxiety, not sure what to expect. However, everything went smooth and the government crackdown and imposed rules did not affect our mission at all. In fact, going in spite of the situation was a pleasant and much welcomed surprise to the churches and organizations who were counting on us coming.

Besides the humility and humbleness a trip like this has on you, it was a rewarding adventure in the realization of how alike we all are; no matter where in the world we live, what circumstances we come from, what color we are or what language we speak. Not only did this trip fuel me to do more of these down the road, it fed my desire to help more with the homeless or impoverished in my own local community. However, the most immediate impact this trip had on me was when we came back home into the heated presidential election and resulting uproar over the results. I had a completely different yet calming perspective about the whole situation. Makes you look at the world through different lenses and realize what's really important in life.
